She will then draft a new mission statement and send it to Soul Fly Band for approval.




Next, we reviewed the Gig Buddies participant application form on the Gig Buddies website.







As a group we looked through the application form and talked about ideas for things to change to make it easier for people to fill out.




Chelsea will make a list of the changes and the team will edit the application form.

Alex and Stavros said that they had a good time, and were asked lots of questions about their role in Soul Fly Band, and their experiences as part of Gig Buddies.




Next, a question was asked about Gig Buddies being involved in next year's Mardi Gras Parade as part of the World Pride event.
