Lachy said that 50 people are allowed in cafes, pubs and restaurants from the Monday $1^{\rm st}$ June 2020. Gig Buddies are allowed to catch up in groups of 10 outside, and inside there can be 5 people without family. People must stay 1.5 metres away from each other.



Online socials have helped people make new friends and widen their social network. This means that Gig Buddies participants can meet up with people who live locally.



Gig Buddies staff believe that local catch ups are the best ways to keep the project running into the future.
