# What is Gig 3 uddies?









Gig Buddies is a

befriending project that matches an adult with learning disability and/or autism to a volunteer with similar interests to attend gigs and



events together.







### who is it for?

A Gig Buddies participant is an adult with mild to moderate learning disability and/or autism, who wants to make new friends and go to events with a gig buddy (volunteer).

A Gig Buddies volunteer is someone who wants to expand their social circles, make friends and go to events with a Gig Buddies participant.

## what do gig buddies do together?

Gig buddies catch up together and see live music gigs, musicals, theatre, opera, movies, sport, visit cafes, art galleries and museums, play golf, go surfing and much more...

it depends on the things you and your buddy









## "buddying" works

Step 1

Sign up to be a participant or volunteer.

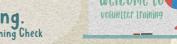
Step 2

We look for a buddy who has similar interests.

Step 3

We provide volunteer training.

volunteers get an NDIS Worker Screening Check





Step 4

We introduce you to your buddy.

Step 5

You and your buddy go out together once a month for 1 year (or more)







## events

The Gig Buddies team also host regular group social events.

These events are open to all participants\*, even if they don't have a buddy.

Gig Buddies group events are a great way to meet new people

parties, pub trivia, theatre, opera, watching sport (AFL,

NRL, cricket, ice hockey, netball and more), bush walks,

comedy, comic con, art galleries, and much more

















#### what are the benefits?

Paired-up buddies catch up every month and do things together, building a friendship over time.

Having a buddy to hang out with and go places can give you more independence.

Going out, meeting people, and having a new friend can help give you confidence.

You and your buddy choose the events you both want to go to. Having a buddy means you can be more adventurous!

Volunteers enjoy the Gig Buddies project because it is flexible. Buddies work together to organise events that suit both their schedules.

all of the above can lead to better mental health, wellbeing and so much more.
